



Stephen R. Lett Scholarship Fund Nominations Now Open

In May 2009, the Men's Golf Association (MGA) established the Stephen R. Lett Scholarship Fund, Inc., in honor of Steve Lett and his leadership as President of Kings Creek Country Club. This is a not-for-profit corporation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. It is funded by donations, special golf events sponsored by the Kings Creek Country Club, the Men's Golf Association (MGA) and the Ladies Golf Association (LGA).

Every year, the Fund awards a \$2,500 scholarship to a deserving college bound high school senior. A first-year recipient may also be eligible for additional scholarship funds their second, third and fourth year of college. In order to qualify, for subsequent years, they must meet certain criteria. A scholarship recipient can receive a total of \$10,000 over a four-year period. To date, the scholarship fund has awarded \$70,000 to deserving recipients.

The Stephen R. Lett Scholarship Fund Board is now accepting your nominations for graduating high school seniors you feel are worthy of this \$2,500 scholarship award for 2018. A candidate must be nominated by a current member or employee of Kings Creek Country Club. The candidate does not have to be related to the member or the employee and does not have to reside in Delaware.

Nominations need to be submitted to our Golf Professional, Kevin Wiest, no later than December 11, 2017. The Nomination Form is attached to this email or is available at the Clubhouse office or can be found on the following websites: www.lettscholarshipfund.com or www.kingscreekcountryclub.com.

The nominee will be asked to submit their completed application by February 17, 2018. The recipient of the Stephen R. Lett Scholarship award for 2018 will be announced in April. The scholarship winner will be selected by an outside, independent committee along with two Scholarship Fund Board members. The recipient will be presented a check for \$2,500 at the annual Lett's Play Golf tournament to be held in July of 2018.

The Selection Committee will base their decision on the following:

- Academics (Grade Point Average and SAT scores).
They must be in the top of their class and college bound.
- Financial need and the student's essay question response.
- Outside activities such as school clubs, community volunteer, etc.
- Letters of recommendation from teachers and others who know the individual.

The process is totally objective and non-biased. We look forward to reviewing many fine applicants, and hope you will complete the following Nomination Form today with your recommendation. We also need your support in order to continue providing these academic scholarships to deserving high school students.
